Waters' Edge (Sonders Fort Collins), currently under development, (226 acres of development plus 453 acres held for development) located in NE Fort Collins. The community of 800



units and retail/office is for empty nesters. All homes back or front to open space and the extensive trail system and amenities.

Mountain Villages, is located south of I-285, behind the hogback in a similar location to Red Rocks Amphitheatre. The site is 84 acres, comprised of 30 acres of development and 54 acres of open space including the red rock out croppings. We anticipate the zoning will have 320 stacked townhouses with spectacular views.
